1. Type: New Admission
Diagnosis: Gastroenteritis and diarrhea
Age: 74 male
Primary Learner: Patient
TB Topic: C-Diff/Contact Plus Precautions
 - Why precautions
 - PPE

2. Type: Post Op Day 2
Diagnosis: Total Hip Replacement
Age: 58
Primary Learner: Patient & Daughter
Topic: Warfarin Education
 - Foods
 - Dose & daily administration
 - Follow up PT/INR check
 - When to call the doctor/go to ED (Fall/SOB)

3. Type: Discharge Day
Diagnosis: Open Cholecystectomy
Age: 38
Primary Learner: Patient
TB Topic: Incision Care
 - Infection Control
 - Signs/Symptoms Infection
 - When to call the Doctor
 - When they can shower
 - Dressing changes

4. Type: Post Chemo Treatment
Diagnosis: Lymphoma
Age: 81
Primary Learner: Daughter
TB Topic: Symptom Management
 - How to take antiemetics
 - How to take pain medication
 - When to call the doctor
 - Expected side effects
 - Non-pharmaceutical interventions

5. Type: Day Two
Diagnosis: Exacerbation of Heart Failure
Age: 75
Primary Learner: Husband
TB Topic: Heart Failure
 - S/S worsening HF
 - Daily Weights
 - Low Sodium food
 - When to call doctor
